

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of June 16, 2021.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on June 16, 2021.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the minutes from the Council meeting of June 2, 2021 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.
