

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of June 2, 2021.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on June 2, 2021.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck, Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer and Buckingham. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the minutes from the Council meeting of May 19, 2021 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the accounts payable for the last half of May in the amount of \$103,860.13 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Commissioner Buckingham said they received 10 lifeguard applications of the 10, 7 passed the pretest and will continue with the licensing at the Ottawa YMCA.

Steven Whelchel would like to put a market garden in allowing people in need to come and get free produce two times a week. There will not a permanent structure on the property only a shed. His next step will to be heard at a plan commission meeting.

Boy Scout Alex Schafer asked the council how they will fix the parking issues for Freedom Run. Also, asked if there will be a Fun Days this year and food vendors since the city was unable to last year due to Covid-19.
