

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of November 3, 2021.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on November 3, 2021.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the minutes from the Council meeting of October 21, 2021 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the accounts payable for the last half of October in the amount of \$582,776.57 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the payroll for the last half of October in the amount of \$67,538.09 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Lewey seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the special event permit for light up Knudson Up Knudson Park and the Santa Parade to be held December 4, 2021 be approved and the permit fee be waived. Moved Commissioner Schaefer seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that pay estimate #2 to John Pohar and Sons in the amount of \$418,605.75 for the route 80 water and sewer extension project be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Lewey seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that Resolution 2021-30, a resolution to purchase a 2021 Ford Explorer for the police department be adopted. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Lewey seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that Resolution 2021-31, a resolution of support and commitment of local funds be adopted. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.
