

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of March 2, 2022.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on March 2, 2022.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck, Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, and Buckingham. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the minutes from the Council meeting of February 16, 2022 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the accounts payable for the last half of February in the amount of \$397,570.59 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the payroll for the last half of February in the amount of \$73,553.05 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Lewey seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the home business license renewal for Eric and Karen Adams DBA E&K Adams firearms and supplies be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Mayor Hollenbeck seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that Resolution 2022-4, a resolution appointing members to the emergency services and disaster services be adopted. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Kaminski that pay estimate #6 to John Pohar and Sons in the amount of \$192,080.70 for the 2021 Route 80 water and sewer extension project be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Mayor Hollenbeck seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that Ordinance 1818, an ordinance amending the City of Marseilles zoning ordinance establishing sign regulations be tabled. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

David Raikes asked the council if he could put a 4X4 marker near Mill Street. The marker is representation of a riot that took place 7/19/1932 in which one person was killed and 21 wounded. After the riot the Laborers Union Local 393 was organized. On 4/28/2022 there will be an event to place the marker and celebrate workers memorial day. The event is sponsored by Laborers International Union of North America and Illinois State Historical Society.

Brad Miller asked the council if they would look into getting one garbage hauler in town.
