

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of August 3, 2022.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the Marseilles Fire Department at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on August 3, 2022.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck, Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, and Buckingham. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the minutes from the council meeting on July 20, 2022 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the accounts payable for the last half of July in the amount of \$344,751.32 be approved and warrants be drawn on the City Treasury for the several amounts. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the payroll for the last half of July in the amount of \$80,375.11 be approved and warrants be drawn on the city treasury for the several amounts. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Schaefer seconded by Commissioner Kaminski that the proposal to Chamlin and Associates in the amount of \$8,000 to prepare plans for the North mill race bridge and Main street bridge over the I&M Canal be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Schaefer seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the proposal to Chamlin and Associates to prepare bridge conditions reports for the Sycamore Street and Washington Street bridges at a cost not to exceed \$2,500 each be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the financial audit for fiscal year 2021-2022 performed by Hopkins and Associates be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that pay estimate number 10 to John Pohar and Sons in the amount of \$227,336.62 for the Route

80 water main and sewer extensions be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Mayor Hollenbeck and Commissioner Lewey thanked the first responders for a successful national night out. Jim Possi with Republic waste services gave an update on the waste pick up issues. Currently more employees have been trained and are taking the efforts to get back to the way they used to be.
