

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of October 5, 2022.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on October 5, 2022.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck, Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, and Buckingham. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the minutes from the Council meeting of September 21, 2022 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the accounts payable for the last half of September in the amount of \$200,937.40 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the payroll for the last half of September in the amount of \$69,354.61 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the payment to Pohar and Sons in the amount of \$54,248.18 for the Route 80 water main and sanitary sewer extensions be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Mayor Hollenbeck questioned the previous councils meeting statement about MAC Donations. He pulled the recreation board minutes from the website that states, "we will match whatever MAC raises in chicken fry to use for maintenance, we will also donate \$5,000 to get a 503 C." Mayor said he did not understand the minutes. Commissioner Schaefer tried to explain insurance alone is \$3,800 and referee's cost a significant amount of money all season. Mayor Hollenbeck also let the council know the central fire panel has not worked since last year and will cost \$11,000 to replace. Commissioner Lewey announced Trick or Treating hours will be on Halloween 5 P.M. – 7 P.M.

Public works superintendent Paul Rivett was presented with a clock for his 10 years of service with the City of Marseilles.

Moved by Commissioner Lewey seconded by Commissioner Kaminski that the City Council adjourns. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None
