

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of November 2, 2022.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on November 2, 2022.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the minutes from the Council meeting of October 19, 2022 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the accounts payable for the last half of October in the amount of \$1,167,658.92 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the payroll for the last half of October in the amount of \$70,780.51 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for said amount. Moved by Commissioner Lewey seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that the special event permit for light up Knudson Up Knudson Park and the Santa Parade to be held December 3, 2022 be approved and the permit fee be waived. Moved Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Lewey that pay estimate #13 to John Pohar and Sons in the amount of \$994,237.20 for the route 80 water and sewer extension project be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the actuarial funding report and the municipal compliance report for the Marseilles Police Pension Fund be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Mayor Hollenbeck seconded by Commissioner Lewey that Ordinance 1827, an ordinance 1827, an ordinance granting zoning map amendment for property at 722 West Bluff Street in Marseilles be adopted. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Mayor Hollenbeck seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that Ordinance 1828, an ordinance granting a conditional use permit for construction of a metal styled garage at 1334 Short Street in Marseilles be adopted. Moved by Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Schaefer that pay estimate #1 to Performance Pipeline in the amount of \$87,058.12 for the Bluff Street sewer lining project be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Schaefer, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Mayor Hollenbeck seconded by Commissioner Lewey that Ordinance 1830, an Ordinance, an ordinance accepting bid and approving sale of 953 Glen Avenue be adopted. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Abstain: Commissioner Schaefer. Nays: None.

Brad Miller addressed the council regarding the newly adopted sign ordinance. He wanted to know why the plan commission works on updating 40 plus year old ordinances if they are not going to be enforced.

Commissioner Schaefer announced MAC flag football season is completed and the banquet will be held 11/4/2022. He also thanked the Fall Fest committee for a wonderful event. Commissioner Buckingham called CSX regarding Pacific Street he will be sending an invoice for reimbursement for the work our City street employees did. City Engineer Mike Etscheid said D Construction poured 80 yards and will be waiting for concrete to complete that part of the job.
