

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of December 7, 2022.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on December 7, 2022.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck, Commissioner Kaminski, and Lewey. Absent: Commissioner Schaefer.

Public Hearing held regarding General Obligation Series 2023.. Mayor Hollenbeck read the minutes of the public hearing. No public comment made.

Ben Swartz with the Boy Scouts presented the council with a large holiday wreath that will be hung outside of City Hall.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the minutes from the Council meeting of November 16, 2022 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the accounts payable for the last half of November in the amount of \$111,334.43 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the payroll for the last half of November in the amount of \$82,177.92 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Mayor Hollenbeck seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that Ordinance 1831, an ordinance granting map amendment for 800 Clark Street be adopted. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Kaminski that pay estimate #3 to Performance Pipeline in the amount of \$182,926.35 for the Bluff Street sewer lining project be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Lewey that pay estimate #14 to John Pohar in the amount of \$49,743.99 for the Route 80 water main and sanitary sewer extensions be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the tax levy 2022-2023 be placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Lewey that the modification of the intergovernmental agreement for communication services between the City of Ottawa and the City of Marseilles be placed be file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Lewey seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that Resolution 2022-27, a resolution authorizing purchase of police vehicle be adopted. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Lewey, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck.. Nays: None.

Chuck Wood with Zero 4 Hero's said he and his board are training golden retriever dogs for first responders with PTSD. Each dog will be trained for 2 years before being released to the first responder. The owner will get free food and vet care for 2 years. This program is 100% funded by donations.
