In January we will be seeking bids for both the Broadway Park revitalization as well as the sidewalk going from the Legion up to 11th Street and Bratton Avenue to 10th Street. Plan is to award bids in March so construction can start in the spring.

What's Ahead

After a few months delay with IDOT the sanitary sewer repairs on East Bluff Street between Chicago and Indiana Street is now scheduled to start July 31st. There will be detours for approximately 5 days as East Bluff Street will be totally closed in the one block construction area.

The city will be televising the sanitary sewer on Illinois Street to see if any repairs are needed before Illinois Street is hopefully paved this year. If repairs are needed, they will be done before paving. We are hopeful we can do other streets as well. A plan is being worked on.
