

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of January 17, 2024.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on January 17, 2024.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck, Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, and Buckingham. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the minutes from the Council meeting of January 3, 2024 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Small that the accounts payable for the first half of January in the amount of \$240,922.72 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Moved by Commissioner Small seconded by Commissioner Kaminski that the monthly department reports for December be approved and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Small that the bids on the Broadway Park Osland Grant be authorized to advertise on January 30, 2024, bids due February 13, 2024, approve bid February 21, 2024. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Buckingham seconded by Commissioner Small that the proposal from Phalen Steel to design plans for City Hall in the amount of \$59,500 be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

The council thanked the city street department employees for their excellent work during the snow storm.
